You can volunteer to work elsewhere including our shops from the age of 16 years old.</p> <p>There is no formal interview for this role but after discussing with a member of the Fundraising Committee and it is decided to proceed you will be asked to complete, for security purposes, a short application form and to arrange for two personal character references. Two passport photographs, proof of address and proof of your right to work in the UK (passport or birth certificate) will also be needed, as well as confirmation that your Tetanus is up to date.</p> <p>On acceptance of your application, you will be given a volunteer card. Please bring this with you each time you come to volunteer.</p>
